Content

- choose five of the following written forms. Choose from both columns.
- Use these forms to reveal something about yourself and your ELA skills.
 - o Hobbies and passions; history; dreams and nightmares; family; spiritual journey; likes and dislikes;
- For a conclusion, include a min. 200 word reflection on the process.
 - o What did you learn about yourself?
 - o Which pieces did you enjoy the most creating? The least?
 - o Which parts of yourself were hardest to express? Why?
 - o What more do you want me to know about you that has not been expressed in this portfolio?
