

My Personal ‘Road to Damascus’



- ◆ Think about a time that you made a decision of spiritual importance.
- ◆ Write your *own* narrative of that decision. Include these points:
 - ◆ where you were “going”(eg. How you were behaving)
 - ◆ what caused the change
 - ◆ how the change has affected the course of your life.
- ◆ If you have not had a moment like that yet, or do not feel comfortable sharing about it, write instead about a time when you made a very important decision about something that changed your life course. Follow the same three bullets
- ◆ Your narrative should be of sufficient length (double spaced, 12 pt font) and show attention to style and grammatical structure.
