

Life in Mr. Wiebe's Classroom

General Expectations

It is the general expectation that we treat each other with respect. That is essentially the bottom line in the relationship that we have been placed into as a result of being in this class together. In general we should seek to act in a way that reflects a decent, humane relationship. This also extends to the physical surroundings of the room, of our possessions, and books and materials. Therefore, this classroom has no rules...(with the following exceptions).

Specifics

- You must be on time(before the bell)
- No feet on desks and do not lean back on chairs.
- No sitting on the tables.
- No food during class time.
- No hats or other head coverings.
- You should not leave the room during instruction times and never leave without permission.
- You should not use cellular phones or other electronic devices in the classroom.
- You must complete assignments.
- You should be involved in classroom discussions and activities.
- **Do not mistake a flexible learning atmosphere for a slack one.**

Regarding Being Late

If you are late for a class you must enter the room silently stop at the bulletin board and sign in (BEFORE GOING TO YOUR DESK). Being late first thing in the morning and after lunch will not be tolerated (some leniency after intramurals). If you are late for first period you must wait outside the door until I let you in when I feel it is appropriate (you **will not** interrupt "O Canada" and devotions).

Regarding Missing a Class

If a student misses a class it is my expectation that he/she will take the initiative to complete all missed work. It is the student's responsibility to make arrangements to complete or receive missed tests, quizzes, homework, handouts, notes, etc.

Regarding Quizzes

The purpose of a quiz is to see if the student is keeping up to date with their understanding a mastery of the material. Quizzes will be written in class usually without prior notice.

Regarding Assignments

- All assignments are to be finished for the assigned due date at the beginning of the class. They will be marked and scores given for each of them.
- Missed assignments will be given a zero unless completed within a short period of time. Marks will be deducted daily at a loss of 10% up to a maximum of 50%.
- If you are absent, it is your responsibility for the assignments missed on that date. The due date extension will depend on how long you have been absent.
- Any assignment due on a day you are absent (valid) will be due on the day you return to class if you have already received the assignment.

Regarding Tests

- All tests are to be written on the assigned date.
- If the student cannot write the test on the assigned day, due to extra-curricular activities, or previous appointments, that student needs to make responsible alternative arrangements BEFORE the assigned test.
- Tests written at alternative times may be an alternate version of the same test.
- If a student misses a test due to an illness or some other unexpected event, that student should let the teacher know by phone (326-3537 ext. 242) or email (swiebe@schs.ca) **before or on the test day.**
- If a test is missed and proactive and responsible arrangements are not made BEFORE or ON the test date, the student will receive an automatic 8% deduction in their test mark and the teacher will determine when the student will write the test.
- **There will be no rewrites.**
