

Bible 10: The New Testament

Purpose:

In this course, you will have opportunities to establish a strong foundation of faith in Christ that can become a known and constant encouragement as you are faced with future variables. Primarily based upon the acts and letters of the Apostle Paul collected in the New Testament, this course is designed to enable you to develop a solid Christian foundation on which your faith will continue to grow.

Format:

Teaching and learning approaches and strategies will include lectures (and note taking), reading, written responses, discussions, journaling, oral presentations, projects, group work, videos, guest speakers, prayer, and memorisation. You will also be required to complete a weekly devotional log and memorize and recite designated scripture. For each unit, you have up until the test date to verbally recite that unit's scripture verses for Miss Duerksen. You will also be asked to complete 8 specific Acts of Kindness throughout the year.

Course Expectations: *You must come to class with the following willingness...*

1. To be kind and respectful to all others, including yourself, your peers, and your teacher.
2. To participate and be active in learning
3. To ask relevant questions
4. To complete assignments promptly and to the best of your ability
5. To arrive to class on time prepared and ready to learn.
6. To obtain notes and assignments if absent
7. To keep an open mind and maintain a positive attitude
8. To keep an open heart - open to God's word and to His Spirit.

Materials: *You must come to every class with.*

1. Notebook/binder
2. Pen or pencil
3. Bible
4. Agenda

If you fail to bring these objects you will be asked to leave class, collect them and then sign in late. Repeat offenders will be dealt with.

Assignment Policies:
