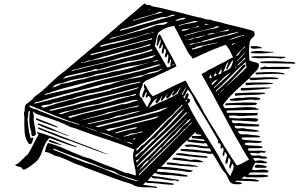


**Bible 10: The New Testament
Memory Verses**



You will be responsible for memorizing these verses (for test dates). You will be asked to write them on the test. All passages are taken from the New International Version.

Unit I

Acts 1:8 But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.

Acts 4:12 Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved.

Unit II

Romans 3:23 For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Romans 10:9 That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord" and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

Romans 12:1-2 Therefore, I urge you brothers, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God - this is your spiritual act of worship. Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is - his good, pleasing, and perfect will.

Unit III

I Cor. 2:14 The man without the Spirit does not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him, and he cannot understand them because they are spiritually discerned.

I Cor. 10:13 No temptation has seized you except what is common to man. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, He will also provide a way out so that you can stand up under it.

II Cor. 4:6-7 For God, who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," made His light shine in our hearts to give us the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of

Christ. But we have this treasure in jars of clay to show that this all-surpassing power is from God and not from us.

II Cor. 12:10 That is why, for Christ's sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecution, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong.

Unit IV:

Eph. 6:10-12 Finally, be strong in the Lord and in His mighty power. Put on the full armour of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the power of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms.

Philemon 4 I always thank my God as I remember you in my prayers.

James 1:5-6 If any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given him. But when he asks, he must believe and not doubt, because he who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind.

Luke 11:2-4 He said to them , "When you pray, say: 'Father, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come. Give us each day our daily bread. Forgive us our sins, for we also forgive everyone who sins against us. And lead us not into temptation'" (note: you may use the version of this verse that you are most familiar with)

Unit V :

Gal. 5:22-23 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.

Gal. 6:10 Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, especially to those who belong to the family of believers.

Eph. 4:2-3 Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love. Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace.

Col. 4:6 Let your conversations always be full of grace, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how to answer everyone.

Heb 13:1-2 Keep on loving each other as brothers. Do not forget to entertain strangers, for by so doing some people have entertained angels without knowing it.

Unit VI:

- Phil. 4:13 I can do everything through Him who gives me strength.
- Phil. 2:14-15 Do everything without complaining or arguing, so that you may become blameless and pure, children of God without fault in a crooked and depraved generation, in which you shine like the stars in the universe.
- Col. 3:12 Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience.
- I Thess. 3:12 May the Lord make your love increase and overflow for each other and for everyone else, just as ours does for you.
- II Thess.2:16-17 May our Lord Jesus Christ himself and God our Father, who loved us and by His grace gave us eternal encouragement and good hope, encourage your heart and strengthen you in every good deed and word.
- II Tim 2:15 Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a workman who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth.
- Titus 3:9 But avoid foolish controversies and genealogies, and arguments and quarrels about the law, because these are unprofitable and useless.

Unit VII

- Heb. 11:1 Now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see.
- James 1:2-4 Consider it pure joy, my brothers, whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know the testing of your faith develops perseverance. Perseverance must finish its work so you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything.
- Rev. 3:20 Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with him and he with me.
- Rev. 4:11 You are worthy, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honour and power, for you created all things and by your will they were created and have their being.
- Rev. 22:17 The Spirit and the Bride say, "Come!" And let him who hears say, "Come!" Whoever is thirsty, let him come; and whoever wishes, let him take the free gift of the water of life.

How to Memorize

1. Read it out loud
2. Write it out
3. Work in small chunks
4. Post it in a place you see every day
5. Record it and listen to it
6. Give it a rhythm; sing it!
7. Create actions to mimic ideas, sounds or action
8. Use anagrams to remember lists (like the fruits of the spirit)
9. Use visualization: see yourself in a place as you recite
10. Use colours, sounds or shapes to represent words
11. Repeat, Repeat, Repeat
